

SURVEY: HBCSD Surplus Land Sale or Exchange

Huntington Beach City School District is considering how best to maximize the use of its assets in the long-term delivery of high-quality education for its students. Over the past few months, the District has embarked upon a study which considers the value of surplus land and how its disposition may improve its facilities. The District believes the sale or exchange of such property could generate \$20+ million, which in turn could be used to pay off previous facility financing, replace aging facilities or augment projects currently identified in Measure Q.
